




# WHAT IS A THEORY OF CHANGE?

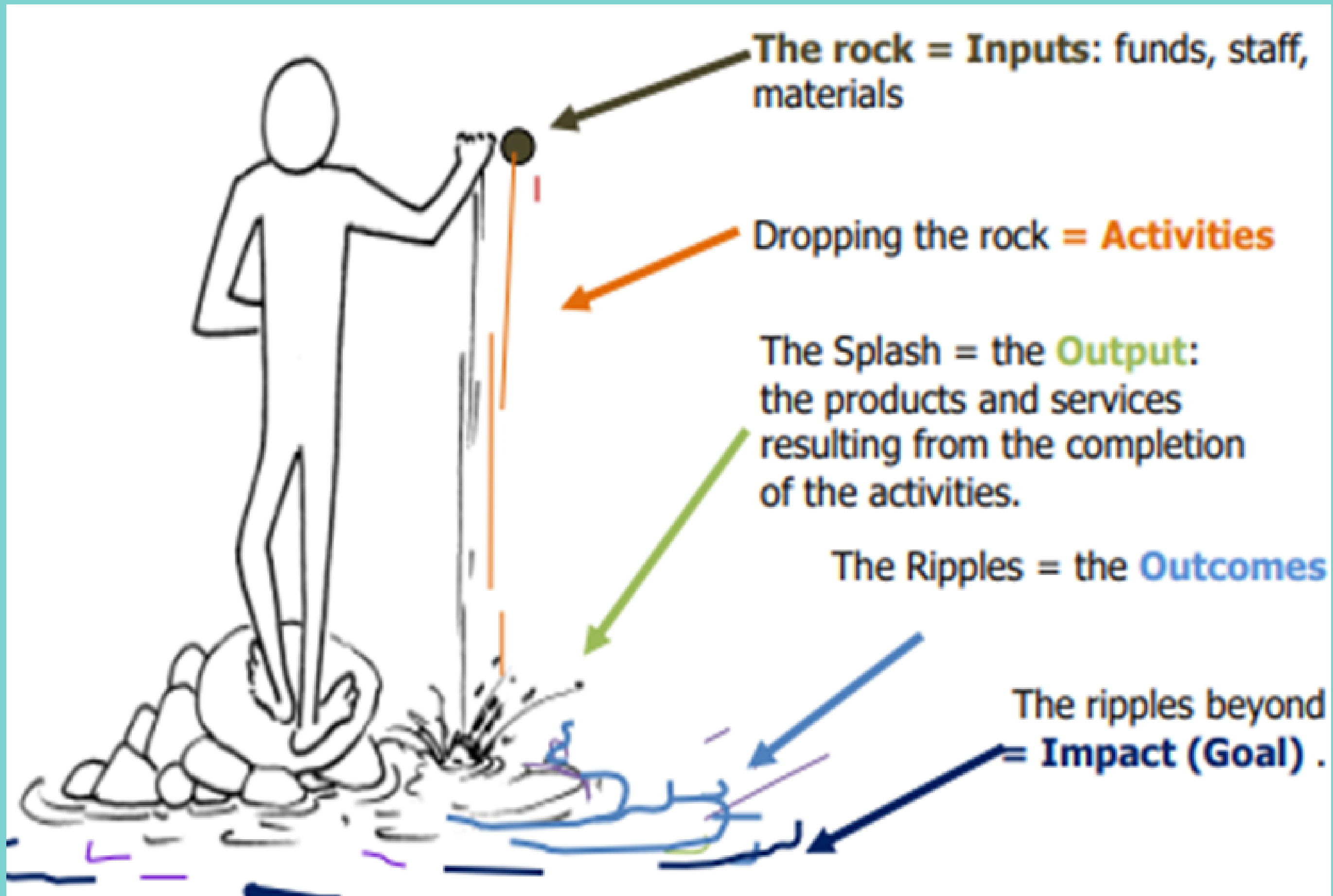


A Theory of Change defines all building blocks required to bring about a given long-term goal. It explains HOW and WHY the desired change is expected to come about.

This set of connected building blocks shows a pathway of change/change framework, which clearly explains the change process.

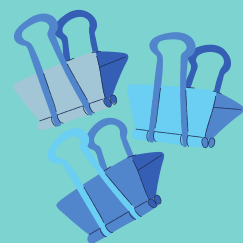

# LOGIC MODEL

The Logic Model is a management tool used to facilitate planning, execution and evaluation of a development intervention.

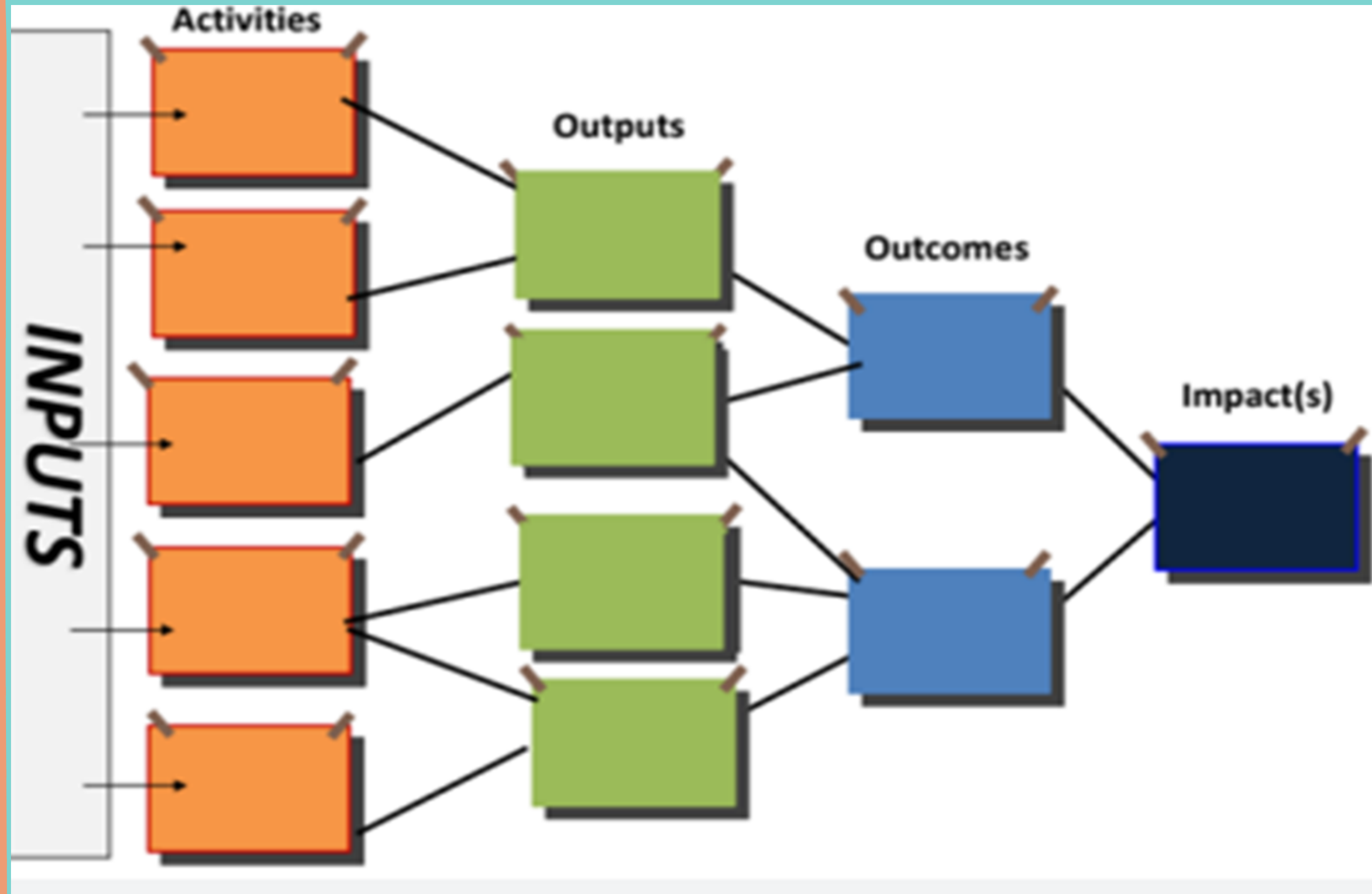


”A logic model is a visual depiction of the main elements of a theory of change for a specific project or program, reflecting the series of changes that are critical to achieving project success. It depicts the logical connections between the planned outputs and the expected outcomes (immediate, intermediate and ultimate) that the project aims to achieve or contribute to. ”
